VI. <u>Trip Description</u>

Hike about 3 miles in and same 3 miles back out. Enjoy seeing and hiking (squeezing?) through unusual, ancient stone formations. VII. Contingency

Virginia Dept. of Conservation and Resources has posted on the Channels Natural Area Preserve webpage that: the parking area is limited to 10 vehicles. If the parking area is full when you arrive, please come back another time. Parking along Highway 80 is not permitted, and violators will be ticketed. The press release also stated: "No parking" signs have been posted along the highway.
