VI. Trip Description

Some families will stay 3 nights, others only 2 nights. Depart CHPC around 8:00 AM Friday with approx. 7-hour drive, stopping for lunch. Arrive at James Island County Park Friday around 4:00 PM to set up tents. Will have a ghost tour in downtown Charleston (approx. 30 min. drive) at 8:00 PM. Eat dinner in route to Ghost Tour. Saturday morning have breakfast in route to Patriots Point for an all-day outing (9:00AM – 6:30PM). We will have access to the USS Yorktown Aircraft Carrier, USS Laffey Destroyer, 3 Acre Vietnam Experience Exhibit, Medal of Honor Museum, 28 Historic Aircraft, and a Cold War Memorial. We will also participate in a scavenger hunt and flight simulator. A variety of food trucks at Patriots Point are available for lunch. Saturday evening return to the campground for dinner and free time. Sunday morning, campers will prepare and eat breakfast. 2-night campers will break camp. All attend a Charleston Harbor Tour Sunday morning (11:30 to 1:00PM). Two-night campers can depart for Kingsport around 2:00PM. Three-night campers can enjoy free time at camp and an evening meal. On Monday, remaining campers will break camp, eat breakfast, and prepare for a final day in Charleston with a self-guided historic walking tour. Departure for Kingsport around 2:00 PM.
