IV. Activities and What to Bring: (not all inclusive, see T-48 Camping Checklist)

Activity	What to Take
Truck-In	Normal truck-in camping equipment and clothing, tents, sleeping system, cooking gear, food by patrol, snacks, no hammocks. Water and a bathhouse are available. Saturday bagged lunch
Backpacking	Normal backpacking gear, food, water filtration, Saturday bagged lunch, snacks Two camp meals (dinner, breakfast) and one trail meal (Sunday lunch)

V. Trip Description:

This trip consists of 2 parts: (A) Backpackers will meet at CHPC at 8:00 AM and carpool to the Backpackers parking lot at Grayson Highlands. They will start on a 9-mile Backpacking Trip to the "Scales" area via part of the Appalachian Trail and the Wilson Creek Trail. They will camp west of Third Peak. An excellent spring is about 200 yards south of the ridge/woods camping area. Trails are rated "moderate difficulty." Meals will be prepared by patrols from their pre-planned menus, cooking with backpacking stoves. The trail route back is via the "Scales" and Big Wilson Creek Trail to the Backpackers parking lot. Two parking spots are reserved in the backpackers parking lot. Note: with enough adult leadership, backpackers may start on Friday, Sept. 11th.

(B) The Truck-In group will meet at CHPC at 8:00 AM and carpool to Grayson Highlands. They will meet at the visitor center and organize day hikes and blueberry picking for the morning and afternoon. They will then organize and travel to the Hickory Ridge Site campground, for check-in at 4:00 PM. Note, earlier check-in will depend on the reservation status of the campsites the previous day. Sites 14,15,16, 17, and 18 are available with 2 vehicles per site and 6 persons per site. A T48 Campfire will be conducted on Saturday night. Bring stories, jokes, and songs to share. Church services are planned for Sunday. Vehicle shuttles will be used between the Campground, Massie Gap, and Visitor Center parking lots. Check-out is by 1:00 PM on Sunday.
