### VI. Trip Description:

Backpackers will assemble @ CHPC at 330 PM, Friday, June 27. Following a quick shakedown, backpackers will drive to the Civic Park Trailhead at 36.653739872853066, -83.43532462761063. Backpackers will hike Friday evening to the White Rock Campsite, prepare camp, and eat. Saturday, they will backpack to the Gibson Gap Campsite (Chadwell alternate) and camp. Sunday, they will backpack to the Wilderness Trail Campground and meet up with truck in campers.

Truck in campers will assemble @ CHPC 7:00 AM on Saturday, June 28 and should depart immediately and arrive at the Wilderness Trail Campground or Visitor Center 2 hours later in the Central Time Zone ~ 8 AM. Truck-in campers may also enjoy day hikes, according to interest.

Following camp set up, truck in campers can depart for a hike by 11 AM, eat a bagged lunch along the hike, and return from the Saturday hike around 6:00 PM. Saturday campers can take the easy 8.4 miles out and back Colson Trail, or as much as adult leadership permits. After the hike, scouts will prepare Dinner and setup for a Troop 48 Style Campfire to be completed in a timely fashion so as to comply with quiet time rules of the campground. On Sunday, all will wake, cook, and break camp. There will be a Troop 48 Church Service at 9:00AM. Truck in campers will wait to meet the backpacking group. The truck in group can explore the visitor center and make the short hike to the overlook and others. All campers will rally at the vehicles to return home around 5:00 PM. There will be a stop along the way for dinner, arriving @ CHPC around 7:30 PM.
