IV. Activities and What to Bring: (not all inclusive, see T-48 Camping Checklist)

Activity	What to Take
Skiing	Please remember to dress warmly and comfortably for your skiing experience. Be prepared to be outside in wintry conditions for several hours. We recommend well-insulated layers and warm, preferably waterproof pants, coat, and gloves/mittens. Ski clothing rentals are available. Skiing and Boarding equipment rentals are available. Lip Balm and Sun Screen should be taken.
Lodging & Food	We will be staying at Evan's Manor, in Rock, WV (AirBnB). Linens and Towels are provided. Bring personal toiletries. Bring sleeping clothes in addition to skiing gear and clothing. Bring a change of clothing in case you get wet during activities. A sleeping bag may be beneficial. We will prepare a food list and plan to cook for Saturday breakfast, Saturday dinner, Sunday Breakfast. All other meals will be bought at the resort or during transit. Bring card games, etc. for entertainment.

V. Trip Description:

Assemble at CHPC at 5:00 PM on Friday, perform roll call and depart for Winterplace Ski Resort. Arrive at approximately 7:30 PM. Check in and gather rented equipment/clothing before 9:00 PM. Depart for lodging at 768 Rich Creek Rd, Rock, WV 24747. Saturday morning, depart for the 20 minute drive to Winterplace Resort and begin tubing/skiing/boarding. Beginner skiing and boarding lessons are available. Winterplace Ski Resort is the perfect place for beginners to learn to ski and more advanced skiers and riders to improve their technique or just spend some time having fun with family and friends. **Parents must print and send in a rental waiver and submit an [online waiver](#) for tubing.**
