Skiing	Please remember to dress warmly and comfortably for your skiing experience. Be prepared to be outside in wintery conditions for several hours. We recommend well-insulated layers and warm, preferably waterproof pants, coat, and gloves/mittens. Ski clothing rentals are available. Skiing and Boarding equipment rentals are available. Please indicate rentals during registration.

#### **V.** Trip Description:

Assemble at CHPC at 4:00 PM on Friday, perform roll call and depart for Appalachian Ski Mountain. Arrive at approximately 6:00 PM. Check in and gather rented equipment/clothing and hit the slopes. Beginner skiing and boarding lessons are available at 7:30 PM. Please indicate class preference during registration. An excellent beginner slope is available for those with limited experience. More advanced slopes are available for advanced skiers. Excellent food is available in the lodge. Skiers can gather inside the lodge in front of the large fire place to warm up periodically. Gather with drivers at around 12:00 PM for the drive to Troop 109 Scout Shack in Boone for the night. Depart for Kingsport at approximately 9:00 AM, stopping for breakfast. The group should arrive back in Kingsport by 12:00 PM.
