VI. <u>Trip Description</u>

The outing includes overnight camping at Camp Davy Crockett Friday and Saturday night; Friday night is optional with check-in from 4:00-6:00 PM. If arriving Saturday, check-in is from 7:00-8:00 AM. We will camp in Black Bear campsites. Cooking and cleanup will be offered to be done by T48 adults for Saturday breakfast to promote maximum event participation (patrol choice). Klondike event staff will operate appointed areas. Patrol activities will include camporee-like participation and competition in a variety of Scout skill events (See Leaders Guide). Six events will be scored by sled groups with up to 10 gold nuggets awarded at each station. There is no sled inspection for points but there is a recommended list of sled items that must be packed. The sled race event will be with no wheels, and individually timed. There is a campsite inspection for a special award. Dinner on Saturday will be provided in the dining hall from 6:00-7:30 PM. A campfire and awards ceremony will be held from 7:30-9:30 PM on Saturday. On Sunday, patrols will prepare their breakfast. There will be a Klondike Church Service in the Chapel from 9:30-10:00 AM. Checkout will be by 12:00. Campsite inspections will be performed by the staff with awards presented at the awards ceremony.

(Troop 48 has 6 sleds that need to be checked and repaired). There will be no Sled Inspections, but a list of Sled Recommendations is provided in the Leaders Guide. The Sled Race will be included in the station rotation where patrols will run their sled through a designated course with each patrol timed for the competition. Every patrol member must participate with the sled. Any sled wheels must be removed for the race. The other events will consist of Shooting Sports, Orienteering, Fire building, Ferry Pull, and a Service Project. Patrols should practice basic scout skills in these areas. Morning events will run from 9:00 A.M – 12:00 PM. Afternoon events will run from 1:00 – 5:00 PM. Events will be spread out throughout Camp Davy Crockett. Be prepared to move and to wait. Scoring will be based how well each patrol works using the patrol method and teamwork. Gold nuggets will be awarded based on the criteria set up by the leaders at each activity. Bonus gold nuggets may be awarded by event planning staff for outstanding scout spirit by individual scouts or patrols.
