IV. <u>Activities and What to Bring</u>: (not all inclusive, see T-48 Camping Checklist)

Activity	What to Take
Truck-In	Normal truck-in camping equipment and clothing, tents, sleeping system, cooking gear, food by patrol, snacks, no hammocks. Saturday bagged lunch
Backpacking	Normal backpacking gear, food, water filtration, Saturday bagged lunch, snacks Two camp meals (dinner, breakfast) and one trail meal (Sunday lunch)

V. Trip Description:

Trip consists of 2 parts: (A) a 9-mile Backpacking Trip from the Visitor Center parking lot at Massie Gap to the "Scales" area via part of the Appalachian Trail and the Wilson Creek Trail. Camping will be west of Third Peak. An excellent spring is about 200 yards south of the ridge/woods camping area. Trails are rated "moderate difficulty." Meals will be prepared by patrols from their pre-planned menus. Cooking with backpacking stoves. The trail route back is via the "Scales" and Big Wilson Creek Trail to the Grayson Highlands Campground. Two parking spots are reserved in the backpackers parking lot. (B) Truck-in Camping in the Hickory Ridge Campground, check-in at 4:00 PM. Sites 15, 16, 17, 18, and 20 are available with 2 vehicles per site and 6 persons per site. Day hikes and blueberry picking are special activities available. Will hold campfires (if weather permits). Bring stories, jokes, and songs to share. Church services are planned for Sunday. Vehicle shuttles will be used between the Campground, Massie Gap, and Visitor Center parking lots. Check-out is by 1:00 PM on Sunday.
