Trip Description

Trip begins by assembling at CHPC on Friday, June 19 at 7:00 AM. The group will check in, assemble, and travel to Charleston SC, stopping for rest breaks and lunch on the way. The group will tent camp in the group camp site in James Island County Park. After arriving Friday afternoon, the group will set up camp and explore the park (fishing, crabbing, water park, etc.). The group will prepare dinner by patrols. Saturday, patrols will prepare breakfast and depart for a tour of Fort Sumter. The early afternoon can be spent sightseeing in Charleston. The group will check in for Operation Overnight aboard the USS Yorktown at 4:00 PM on Saturday. Sunday morning, the group will explore the USS Yorktown and other museums at Patriot Point. Lunch will be purchased on site. The group will return to the campsite Sunday evening and prepare a patrol dinner, or eat out at a restaurant. The group will return to Charleston for a Ghost Tour at 10:00 PM and return to camp afterwards. Monday morning, patrols will prepare breakfast and break camp. The group will leave around 10:00 AM and return to Kingsport, eating lunch and possibly dinner while in route.
