V. What to bring

VI. Trip Description

The trip begins by assembling at CHPC on Friday, July 24 at 7:00 AM. The group will check in, assemble, and travel to Charleston SC, stopping for rest breaks and a self-pay lunch on the way. The group will camp in tents in the group camp site in James Island County Park, Primitive Group Site A with a 1:00 PM Check In. No hammock sites are available. After arriving Friday afternoon, the group will set up camp and explore the park (fishing, crabbing, water park, etc.). The group will prepare dinner by patrols using camp stoves & gear (no patrol boxes). Saturday, patrols will prepare breakfast and depart for a tour of Fort Sumter with pick up at Liberty Square from 9:30 AM – Noon. Parking will cost approx.\$24 per car. The early afternoon can be spent eating lunch (self-paid) and sightseeing in Charleston, museums and Charleston City Market are within walking distance. The group will depart for Patriots Point by 3:00 PM. Check in for Operation Overnight aboard the USS Yorktown is at 4:00 PM on Saturday. Food for dinner and breakfast will be ordered and delivered to the ship. Sunday morning, the group will explore the USS Yorktown and other museums at Patriot Point. Lunch (self-paid) will be purchased on site. The group will return to the campsite Sunday evening and prepare a

patrol dinner, or eat out at a restaurant. The group will return to Charleston for a Ghost Tour at 9:30 PM and return to camp afterwards. Monday morning, patrols will prepare breakfast and break camp. The group will leave around 10:00 AM (Check Out 11:00 AM) and return to Kingsport, eating lunch (self-paid) and possibly dinner (self-paid) while in route.
